

The 2016 ACM-ICPC Asia Hong Kong Regional Contest

RCD Report

The 2016 ACM-ICPC Asia Hong Kong Regional Contest has successfully completed. The contest was held on 5-6 Nov 2016, and was hosted by the Department of Computer Science and Engineering, The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK). The registration, opening ceremony, and practice session were held on 5 Nov. The Regional Contest, solution sharing session, award ceremony, and banquet were held on 6 Nov.

Teams participated in the Regional Contest via two channels. First, an Online Preliminary was held on 10 Sep 2016. There were 152 teams accepted for the Preliminary, and 43 teams successfully advanced to the Regional Contest. Second, 14 teams were invited to participate in the Regional Contest. Altogether, 57 teams, representing 42 institutes, participated in the Regional Contest.

The problem set of the Regional Contest consisted of 11 problems. All but one problem were successfully solved by at least one team. One problem (G) received even no attempts. In all, 517 attempts were received and 105 of them (20.3%) were judged correct.

The Champion, First Runner-up, and Second Runner-up solved 8, 8, and 5 problems respectively. Teams ranked 1–5 received Gold Awards. Teams ranked 6–10 received Silver Awards. Teams ranked 11–15 received Bronze Awards. Other than these, teams solving two or more problems received Honourable Mention. Five teams won the First Team to Solve Problem [A/B/C/D/E/F/H/I/J/K] awards.
