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From 2004 to March 2006, the Ministry of Public Security of the People's Republic of China has issued over 150 millions of ID cards with IC chips.

These 1183 characters have been used in these ID cards.

For these 1183 characters, there are:

- (1) 174 characters used for Place Name, referenced to file “IRGN1262_SubmittedToD_APart1.pdf”.
- (2) 60 characters used for Family Name, referenced to file “IRGN1262_SubmittedToD_APart2.pdf”;
- (3) 949 characters used for Personal Name, referenced to file “IRGN1262_SubmittedToD_APart3.pdf”.

We have the source information for each of these characters. For example:

𪛇, C1 V2.0 No. is 14910, is used for Place Name in 4 provinces, they

are Fujian, Guangdong, Jiangxi and Zhejiang.

We submit these 1183 characters to CJK D.

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
