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Title:	Request to add 24 new characters to CJK D
Source:	TCA
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This document reports TCA new repertoire to include in the CJK Unified Ideographs Extension and TCA wants to discuss the possibility to put this into CJK extension D, cause this is an urgent issue for Taiwan.

As mentioned in TCA activity report (IRG 1290), The Ministry of Education in Taiwan published about 2772 frequently used Chinese characters for Taiwanese and 2518 Chinese characters for Hakka dialect in May 2007 which has been using in the school book and governmental services, and found 33 characters are not included in ISO/IEC 10646.

TCA is studying the 33 characters and draft this proposal of 24 characters which is input from MOE (note: 9 characters are dropped because of the unification)

Status of study on the proposed characters is as below. See attachment for detail.

- Bitmap font: 128\*128 are ready.

  - Stroke count – done
