

## Appendix A

In Annex S there are many examples of a difference of one small stroke between two characters with the same horizontal shape. A method to find these is:-

- (1) Look at the reading or meaning of a proposed character.
- (2) Look for already encoded characters with the same reading or meaning but only one small stroke different.

Type One -- A difference of a dot or small stroke

1.a inside 国 U+56EF vs 国 U+56FD

1.b on edge 戾 U+623B vs 戾 U+623E

1.c touching 鄉 U+90F7 vs 鄉 U+9109
