

UTC Urgently Needed Ideographs

The Unicode Technical Committee is submitting in two separate documents data on the seventeen ideographs from our Extension D submission whose encoding is needed urgently. These are seventeen ideographs used by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in its Hong Kong operations. They were originally submitted as part of Extension C but were among the characters whose consideration was deferred until Extension D.

All pertinent data regarding these characters is available except for the evidence of use, which we are still in the process of gathering.

Data on these seventeen ideographs is available in two other documents, a PDF containing the glyphs, and a text file containing the C1 code, the U-source index, the radical-stroke count, the KangXi position, the first stroke, and for all the characters where one is available, the IDS.
