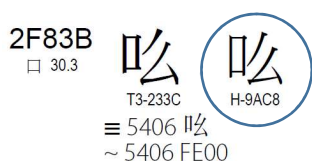
The Hong Kong Special Administrative Region’s Feedback on IRGN2337

IRGN2337 proposed to disunify U+2F83B. This document provides feedback as follows.

1. U+2F83B is included in the Hong Kong Supplementary Character Set – 2016 (see Picture 1). The glyph and the source reference (H-9AC8) are found in the H-column of U+2F83B in ISO/IEC 10646:2017 (see Picture 2). U+2F83B is unified to U+5406.

2. The glyphs of U+5406 are shown in ISO/IEC 10646:2017 (see Picture 3).

3. In the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR), “𠵼” (U+2F83B) is a variant of “𠵼” (U+5406). The existing code point (2F83B) for H-9AC8 should be maintained. As such, the HKSAR will not request the disunification of U+2F83B from U+5406 or the assignment of a new code point for H-9AC8 in the Unified Repertoire and Ordering.
