Editors from China, Japan, R.O.Korea, TCA, HKSARG, Unicode Consortium, SAT, Mr. Henry Chan (individual) met during IRG#48. The editorial group discussed the IRG Working Set 2015 issues.

1. Stroke Counting

Reference:

The editors reviewed and discussed the feedbacks only, because the document IRGN2171 was already reviewed during the previous IRG meeting. The editors asked the author of IRGN2171 (Chen Zhuang) to update the document according to the discussions by 2017-07-21. The Updated IRGN2171 will be followed in IRG working sets.

2. Display of IRG Working Set charts

The editors agreed to remove the FS entry, add IDS entry and Total Stroke entry to the IRG Working Set charts. The editors required the IRG Chief Editor to adjust the charts in IRG WS 2015 new version.

3. IRG Working Set 2015 Comments

The editors reviewed and discussed all comments on unifications and dis-unifications, radicals, glyph designs, and evidences listed in table 1 to 5 of the “consolidated comments”. Comments in table 6 are editorial issues then will be checked and fixed by the IRG Chief Editor. The IRG Chief Editor will also check stroke count comments, follow the updated IRGN2171.

4. IRG Working Set 2015 Review Schedule

- IRGN2215 One More Review Round for IRG WS2015 is Necessary (Japan)

The editors agreed to take one more review round for IRG WS2015 for high quality as suggested in IRGN2215, although it was recommended frozen by the end of IRG#48. Thus, the editors set the schedule below.

- 2017-07-21: The IRG Chief Editor distributes updated IRGN2171 IRG Stroke Count Guidelines.
- 2017-07-21: The related IRG members submit updated bitmap fonts to the IRG Chief Editor.
- 2017-08-04: The IRG Chief Editor distributes IRGN2223 IRG WS 2015 v4.0.
- 2017-09-01: The IRG members' chief editors submit review comments to the IRG Chief Editor.
- 2017-09-15: The IRG Chief Editor distributes consolidated comments.
- 2017-10-06: The IRG members' chief editors submit responses to the consolidated

comments to the IRG Rapporteur.

4. IRG Working Set 2017

The editors agreed to control to size of IRG Working Set 2017, thus every submission would be limited to less than 1,000 characters. All the submissions must be subject to the requirements specified in IRG PNP, and be submitted by 2017-09-15.

The estimated size: ~5000

- UTC: 100 (place names)
- UK: 1000 (dialects, place names, family names, transcriptions for Old Hanzi characters)
- ROK: ~1000 (person names and place names)
- SAT: 500 (Buddhist texts)
- TCA: ~1000 (names and characters from dictionaries)
- China: 1000 (place names and scientific characters)
