Subject: Latest list of Mis-Unifiable Components?

Prof. Lu,

On the IRG website's (outdated) Working Document Series page, the link to MUC (Mis-Unifiable Components list) appears to be broken. All the other links (UCV, NUC) work, but they seem outdated compared to the newest versions posted in the IRG48 page (N2242, N2243 respectively). Do you recall when was MUC last updated and if there is a working link to it? (It does not appear to be present in the Google Drive LargeFiles folder where the latest UCV & NUCV are hosted.)

Also, it seems that some rule numbers are absent from both UCV & NUCV lists; three examples are #10, #12, & #14. (UCV goes from 1 to 9, skips to 11, then to 13, and so on, while NUCV starts at 256a.) Were they former UCV and/or NUC rules that were deleted from IWDS altogether, or are they actually MUC rules?
