Dear Dr. Lu,

I suggest three additional minor edits to 4.1 Guidelines for M-set (Page 16) to better reflect the ongoing IRG practice.

Per the item "Wrong Kangxi Radical / stroke count / first stroke", we typically do not move a character to the D-set for further checking if a new Radical / stroke count / first stroke is decided during the meeting.

It is suggested to be amended to "Data will be corrected" and "Moved to the D-set for further manual checking" be listed as two different resolutions.

A similar case also applies to the item "Wrong or missing glyph". We typically do not move a character to the D-set if the new evidence is provided before the meeting and accepted during the meeting. It is suggested that the possible resolutions be changed to the two items "A new glyph is supplied and accepted or the missing glyph is supplied" and "Moved to D-set pending new glyph".

I also suggest that the comment type "Evidence is not clear" be added to the table, and the list of possible resolutions be "Evidence is supplied and accepted" and "Moved to the D-set pending further evidence". Although comment on glyph design and comment on evidence is usually grouped together in the review, it deserves to be listed in the PnP so participants are not confused.
