Correct, we previously confirmed this in our response to IRGN2270 last May. The evidence we have for this is from "Tù Điền Chử Nôm Tày" (excerpt below) and shows that 𠄎𠄎土己心 is the intended overall shape. Also, the reading "cợ" suggests that 己 U+5DF1, read "kì" not 巳 U+5DF2, read "dĩ", is correct.

This character (aka U+2BB7B) is currently written as 𠄎土𠄎己心. The IRG is discussing its relationship to 𠄎𠄎土己心. The current evidence suggests that 𠄎𠄎土己心 may actually be the correct shape, which would mean a change to the Extension B code charts and a radical-stroke change. It would also make possible a unification with a PRC character. Could you confirm whether V4-445A is supposed to be 𠄎土𠄎己心 or 𠄎𠄎土己心?
