U+22C3A is 𠄎才負. This is based on the reading "phũ", derived from the phonetic 負 ("phụ" = Mandarin "fù"). Given that this was encoded some time ago in extension B, we would oppose moving V2-7729 to Extension G.

Ireland requests the removal of U+3050C (UK-02790) from CJK Unified Ideographs Extension G with U+22C3A. See attached image. (The T glyph form is anomalous, but as it has the same character as UK-02790.).

It is true that U+3050C 損 looks a lot like V2-7729. But the alternative solution may be to move U+3050C to the position U+3050C. This should be discussed by IRG experts at IRG #52 before de
