Adding Lu Qin and Chen Zhuang,  
I found the reason, the WS2017 6.0 spreadsheet had that entry with a 4 digits value for the WS2017 index, see:  
04539,,169,8,1,0,門所,16,,,,USAT07232,,,  
5030,,169,8,5,0,門录,16,GZ-4322205,,,,,  
04540,,169,9,4,0,門皇,17,,KC-07886,,,,,

Because of that, the regex missed that entry (it was the only line with a WS2017 value of 4 digits instead of 5, so I didn't catch it). It is not like anyone gives me a formal syntax of the columns, so I have to visually inspect them and then create regex rules to read the file.

So I will add it after the SAT character, currently at U+3222D. BTW I should have known, the excel file has 4193 valid entries, one more than current 4192. With the other one being removed, we are back at 4192, which is a nice round number. I don't need a ballot comment for that one, although it would be nice to have IRG support for what was an omission, the character was part of the WS2017 6.0 repertoire so there is no debate.  
(it also shows that it is important to have regular entries)

I will regenerate as soon as I get more info about the character to remove

I verified it's in the attributes file for both Working Set v5.2 and also v6.0. Do you have any idea why it would be missing from the charts?
