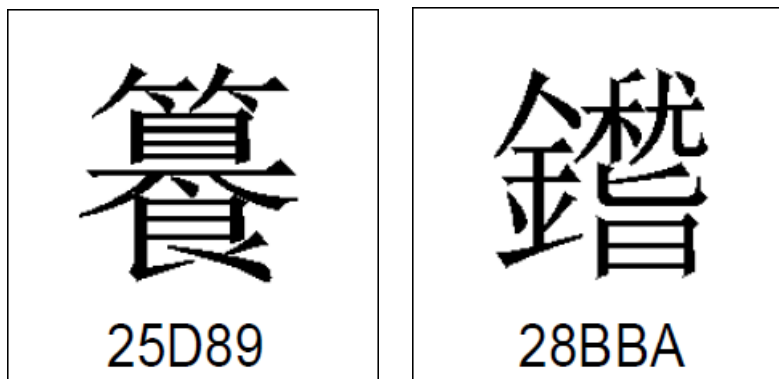

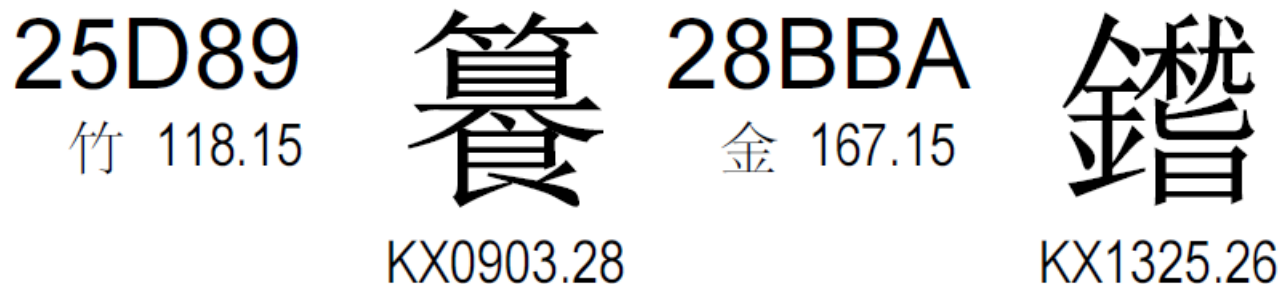

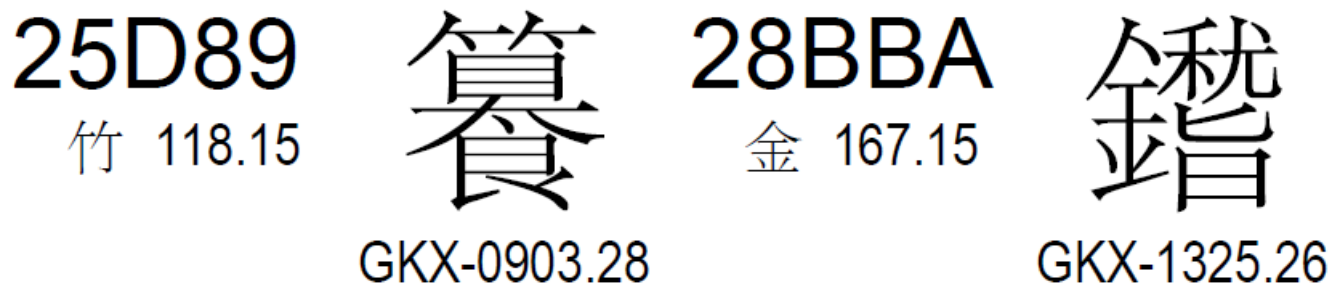

1. U+25D89

This is the 28th character on page 903 of the Kangxi Dictionary (康熙字典):

It has 目一八 (not 大) right under the 目. The 丿 stroke does not penetrate the horizontal stroke.

Therefore, the G glyph for U+25D89 should be changed back to 𠄎 (with 目一八 instead of 大).

2. U+28BBA

This is the 26th character on page 1325 of the Kangxi Dictionary:

It is unclear whether the character has 禾 or 禾, because the top curved stroke of the top-middle component slightly extends to the left of its vertical stroke.

I therefore defer to the judgment of IRG experts as to what action, if any, should be taken with regard to the G glyph for U+28BBA.

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
