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### 1. Submitting plan for WS2024

China plans to submit around 1000+ characters to WS2024.

751 Chinese characters are from the Project “Chinese Characters Repertoire”, Tencent's Chinese Character Protection Project, Center for Toponym Research of Sichuan International Studies University, Zhonghua Book Company, Culture and Art Publishing House, China Electronics Standardization Institute.

And 300 Zhuang characters sorted by Guangxi University.

### 2. Completion of GB 18030-2022/Amd 1 *Information technology -- Chinese coded character set--Amendment 1*

The text and code charts of GB 18030-2022/Amd. 1 has been completed and submitted to the administrations in Feb. 2024. It is expected released this year.

The main additions to GB 18030-2022 are CJK Unified Ideographs G, H, I from UCS. All newly added CJK ideographs are to be implemented in Level 3 of the standard, 1 year after releasement of this AMD.

### 3. A Research Project on GB 18030-2022

The Project of National Social Science Foundation of China 2023: “GB 18030-2022 Chinese Character Sorting and Resource Library”, to be

carried on by Prof. Li Guoying (李国英) team, was officially founded early this year.

The project aims to establish a complete attributes database, in order to improve the efficiency of character set use. All CJK unified ideographs in the standard will be identified for their pronunciations and meanings, and be corrected for their normalized and traditional glyphs.
